

Facetime Video and Voice Calls



Where you can use Facetime

You and your recipient can make a Facetime video or voice call from any Apple device.

What you need

- An apple device with a microphone and speakers and a webcam (if making video calls)
- The recipient with Facetime on their device
- An internet connection

Setting up the Apps

Facetime is already loaded on your iPad and iPhone. You can use your apple id and password, an email address, and/or your phone number to make and receive calls – and have the same account open on multiple devices.

Making a Facetime Video Call

Option 1: with Facetime App – and a contact in your contact list

- 1. Open your Facetime App
- 2. Click on + at the top to access your contacts
- 3. Click on your Contacts name in the contact list (use the search box if required)
- 4. Click on the picture of the Video Recorder to start the video call
- 5. WAIT for the connection
- 6. To end your video call, tap the red end call icon or red receiver.

Option 2: with Facetime app - and a contact not in your contact list

- 1. Open your Facetime App
- 2. Click on + at the top to access your contacts
- 3. Type their name, phone number or email address in the contact list
- 4. Tap the Video or Audio at the bottom
- 5. WAIT for the connection
- 6. To end your video call, tap the red end call icon or red receiver.

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Option 3: with Contact App

- 1. Open your Contacts app
- 2. Click on your Contacts name in the contact list (use the search box if required)
- 3. Click on the picture of the Video Recorder to start the video call
- 4. WAIT for the connection
- 5. To end your video call, tap the red end call icon or red receiver.

Viewing Recent Facetime Calls

- 1. Open the Facetime App
- 2. Tap on Video or Audio
- 3. View recent Video or Audio calls (red are those missed, white are those that have connected)
- 4. If you would like to return the call, just tap on the phone number or name
